





INVOLVEMENT POLICY

Economic Growth between UK and Jamaica can be further enhanced by the strong people to people links that exist between UK and USA Business and Professional Diasporas. This has been achieved by joint regional dialogues, forums and conferences.

The UK will lead on multi-sector trade and services for cluster development and the USA will lead on medical missions for clinical and non-clinical health professionals.

A UK/USA joint approach has been developed to scale-up the Diaspora Delivery System (DDS) as a knowledge driven approach, in order to value the creation and co-ordination of assets, data, management systems, resources, skills and supply chain collaboration:

- Ensure evidence informs policy formulation and adoption is key to involvement of professional services and practitioners with a proven track record of achievement within host countries.
- Encourage a culture of collaboration, trust and co-operation among intermediaries, dedicated to facilitating cohesive, productive and effective team working.
- Facilitate the integration of skills, expertise and resources within technology, education, health, community tourism, supportive housing and diplomacy to provide system enabled, high quality, accessible and mutually sustainable services.
- Promote UK/USA Diaspora networking with academic institutions, knowledge management and technology partners for utilising the intangible assets of Intellectual Capital and Traditional Knowledge as leverage for creativity and competitive advantage.
